



## How to access Zinio Digital Magazines

- Zinio is an online magazine source. You will have access to KCPL's Zinio subscriptions using the KCPL Zinio Gateway as your starting point.
- You will need your card number the first time you use Zinio.
- The email and password that you choose must be the same for both the KCPL page at Recorded Books and at Zinio itself. If you install one of the Apps it should also be the same email and password.
- KCPL purchases subscriptions to a title at Zinio just like we do with our print magazine titles. We do not subscribe to all of the magazines Zinio has to offer, but we have a good selection.
- You will see magazines to subscribe to at Zinio, but to check out magazines for free you will always start at the KCPL Zinio Gateway.
- Users will be able to check out their favorite titles each month using KCPL's Zinio service.
- Magazines can be checked out and read online without any software as long as the user has access to the internet.
- Magazines can also be downloaded and read when the internet is not available by downloading one of the Zinio Apps or the Zinio Reader.
- While most magazines don't take up a lot of space on a computer or device, users can delete an issue downloaded into an App when they don't need the issue anymore.

## Getting Started

1. Click on the link to the KCPL Zinio Gateway at our webpage. <http://kanawhalibrary.org/>
2. In the upper right of the Gateway, you can log in or create an account. Click on *Create New Account*, and then enter your KCPL card number.

- Next, you will create your login that you will use from now on to check out magazines. You will use the same email and password for all of your Zinio logins.

- Once you have logged in, you will see “Welcome,” and your first name will appear in the upper corner. You will also get an email confirmation from the service.
- You can search our selection of magazines by:
  - Searching the name of a magazine in the search box.
  - Looking at magazines by genre grouping.
  - Scrolling through our titles, page by page.
- You can check out the current edition of a title by clicking on *Check Out Now* beneath the cover image. If back issues of a magazine are available, you can click on the magazine cover or the words *Back Issue Available*. Back issues start with the start date of the KCPL subscription.
- When you click on Checkout Now, you have the following options:



- Start reading*, which will take you to the Zinio site to read the magazine online.
- Go to your software or App to download the magazine or read it online.
- Keep browsing and check out more titles.

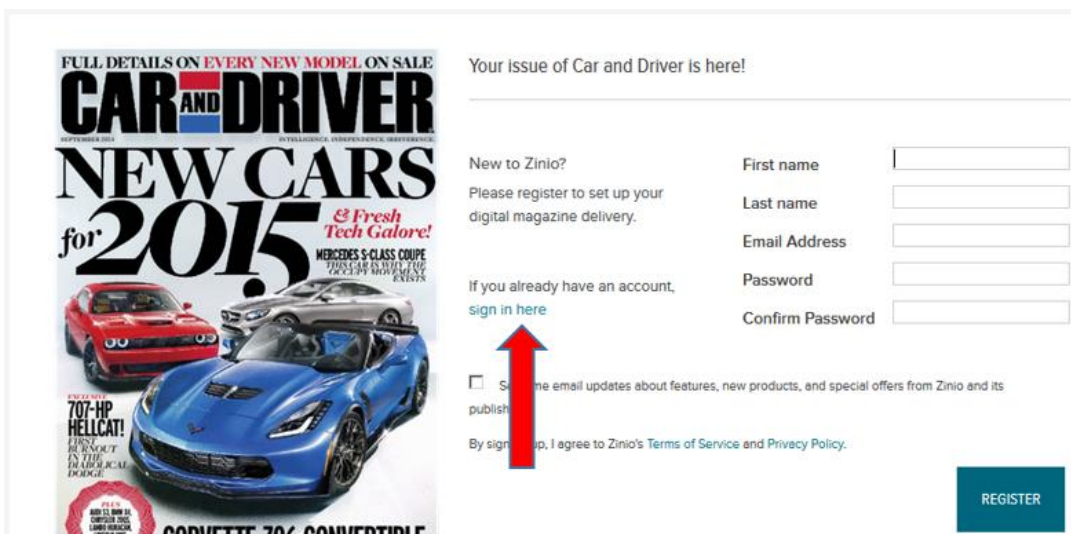

**Have you created a zinio.com personal reading list account?** If not, you will need to click "Create a Zinio account" in the pop up screen after "Start Reading."

Please be advised that once you click Start Reading, you are leaving your library's RBDigital Gateway site and entering Zinio.com, the commercial site where you can read your checked out magazines. Zinio.com also offers the option to search and subscribe to paid-for magazines not available in your library collection.

8. The first time you go to Zinio, you will register with the same email address and password. After that, you will simply sign in. This is also where you opt-in or out to get updates and special offers from Zinio. You will also get a confirmation letter from Zinio.



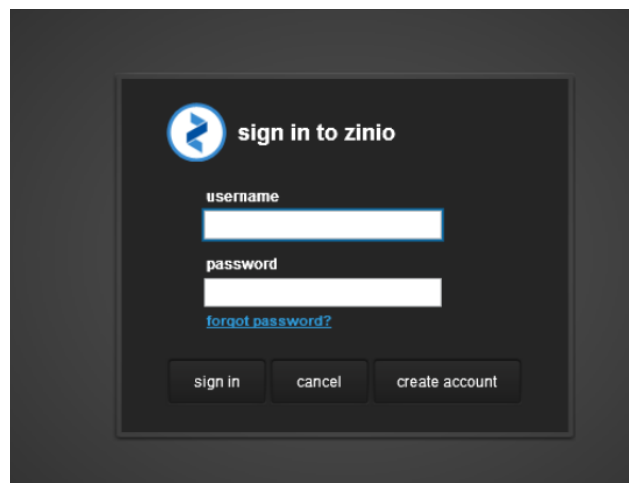
9. This is the screen you will see at Zinio when you log in after your initial registration:



10. Now you will be ready to read a magazine while connected to the internet. The magazines you have checked out will be in the *Your Library* section.
11. Clicking on the cover will open the issue in the online reader. Help in navigating will pop up.
12. At this point the magazine is being read on the internet and not downloaded.

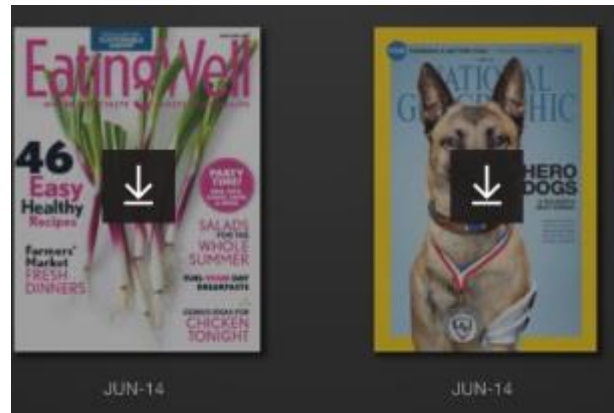
## Zinio Apps and Reader

13. If you want to download the magazine to read on the go, you will need to download a Zinio App for your device or the Zinio Reader. You will see links to the following at the bottom of the Gateway page.
  - a. iPhone at the iTunes store.
  - b. iPad at the iTunes store.
  - c. Android devices at the Google Play store.
  - d. Win 8 for Microsoft tablets at the Windows Store.
  - e. Mac downloads Adobe Air and then the Zinio Reader at Zinio.
  - f. PCs download Adobe Air and then the Zinio Reader at Zinio.
  - g. Kindle Fire/HD/HDX download an App at Zinio and will say “yes” to the Third Party App question. (more info - <http://imgs.zinio.com/faq/kindlefire.html> )
  - h. Nooks are not currently compatible with Zinio as an App.
14. You will create your account using the same information, so that magazines will go from the KCPL Zinio Gateway to your Zinio App or reader.



15. Users can have more than one login on the same App, if you share the device with family members.
16. To get new issues of your favorite magazines, you will start at the KCPL Zinio Gateway and check them out. You will not need to go to the Zinio page. Open your App where the internet is available for the new issue to show up in the App.
17. The magazines you have borrowed will be in *READ / Your Library*. As with reading them over at Zinio online, you will see offers to subscribe to magazines. If you want to borrow from the library, you always start at the KCPL Zinio Gateway.

18. When you are in *Your Library* you will see your covers, which can be sorted by date and title. Clicking on the arrow, when the internet is available, will download the magazine to be read away from internet access.



19. The App can be set to default to “READ” in the *Account Settings*.

20. Remember:

- a. Search for and checkout magazines for free in KCPL’s Zinio Gateway
- b. Read them in your Zinio App.
